

## **Pre-Inspection Checklist**

Arrange or confirm entry to the property with all parties, including your Real Estate Agent and the Seller or Builder.
Make sure all utilities such as gas, water, and electricity are turned on.
If property is newly built, ensure that a Municipal Occupancy Permit has been issued and the property is in a livable condition
If instead the property is a re-sale property, ensure that a Municipal Occupancy Permit has been issued and the property is not under major renovation or construction.
Make sure the following spaces are accessible and obstruction free:
☐ Kitchen & Bathroom Plumbing
□ Water Heater
□ Furnace
□ Electric Panel
☐ Attic & Crawl Spaces.
If you have any pets that may cause issues, please move them somewhere safe for the inspection.
Print out the Pre-Inspection Agreement and read and sign it.
